Intertekstualiteit (p. 74 - 75)

Soos daar in Hulpbron 7 bespreek is, verwys verskillende tekste soms na mekaar. Dit noem ons intertekstualiteit. Ons kry eintlik twee soorte verbande wanneer ons na sulke tipe verwysings kyk – intratekstuele verbande en intertekstuele verbande.

Intratekstuele verbande beteken dat verskillende elemente *in 'n teks* na mekaar verwys. Daar is m.a.w verwysings in een teks wat met mekaar verband hou. Byvoorbeeld: 'n Karakter in 'n boek wat spesifieke woorde herhaal. Wanneer daar later in die boek weer na hierdie woorde verwys word, is dit 'n intratekstuele verwysing na die karakter.

Intertekstuele verbande beteken dat elemente buite die teks met die teks verbind. Dit is m.a.w verbande of verwysings *tussen tekste*. Byvoorbeeld: Wanneer jy 'n film kyk en een karakter verwys na die mitologiese god, Zeus, dan is dit 'n intertekstuele verwysing na die Griekse mitologie.

Intertextuality (p. 74 - 75)

As already mentioned in Resource 7, different texts sometimes refer to each other. This is called intertextuality. There are two types of links we must consider when we talk about intertextuality – “intratekstuele verbande” (intratextual links) and “intertekstuele verbande” (intertextual links).

“Intratekstueel” means that different elements ***in a single text*** refer to each other. For example: A character in a book that uses a specific saying. When a reference is made to this saying at a later stage in the book, it would be an intratextual reference to the character.

“Intertekstueel” refers to links or references ***between different texts***. For example: When a character in a film makes a reference to Zeus, the mythological god, it is an intertextual reference to Greek mythology.
