ANSWER ANY TWO OF THE FOLLOWING THREE QUESTIONS:

 - (b) responsible life choices
 - (c) purposeful and value-driven behaviour
 - (d) the search for meaning
 - (e) attitude

- (5) Discuss social and cultural forces which strongly influence South Africa or a country of your choice, at both global and regional level (15)
