Question

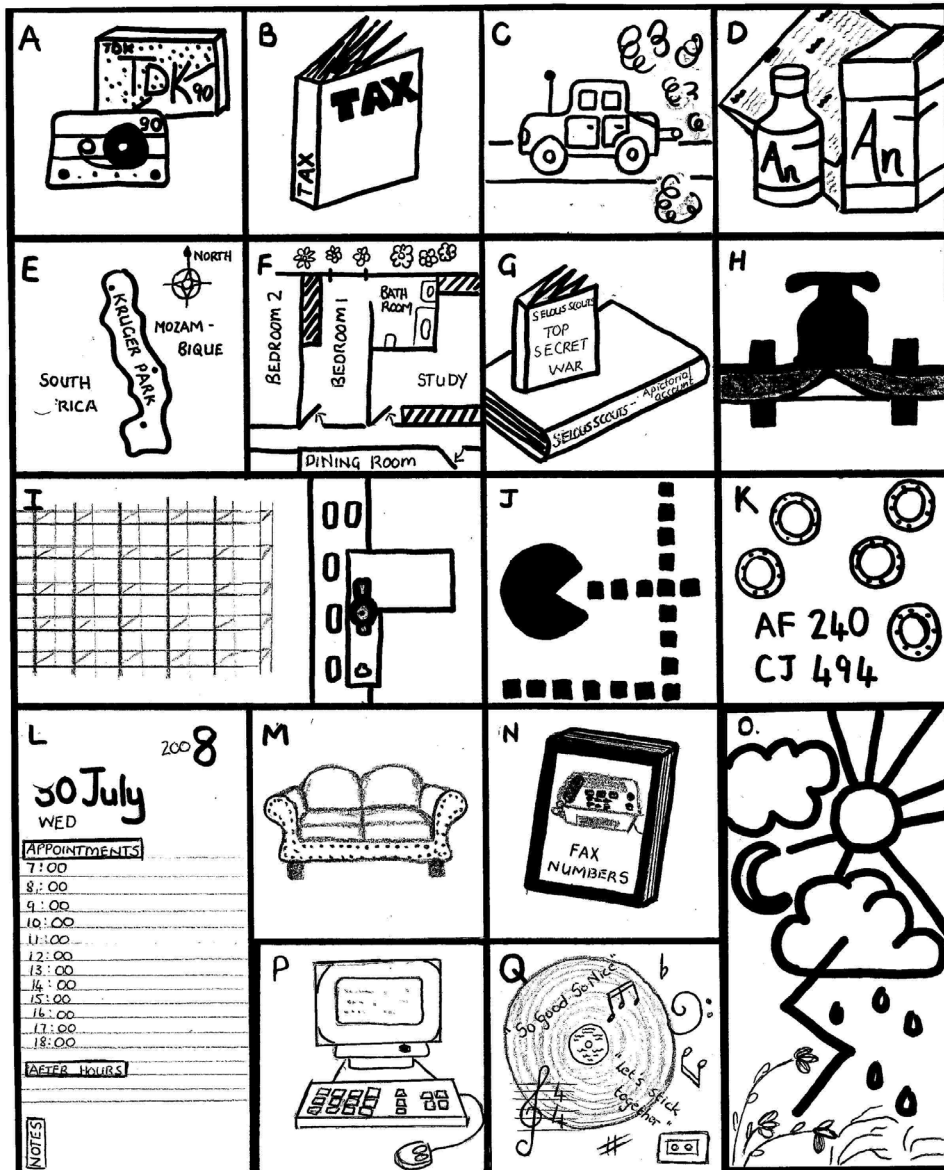

1. The *King* case was about a number of weather **computer programs** written by an employee of the weather bureau.
2. The *Haupt* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in a **computer program** called the Data Explorer, certain tables (database structures) and databases, the database structures and databases being **literary works**.
3. The *Dexion* case dealt with the alleged infringement of copyright in four technical drawings (**artistic works**) reflecting different parts of Dexion's Speedlock racking system.
4. The *Biotech* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in the package insert (**literary work**) for a generic drug called Augmentin.
5. The *Marais* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in architectural drawings (**artistic works**)
6. The *Jacana* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in a map of the Kruger National Park (**artistic work**), a grid showing the facilities at different camps (**literary work**), and the rules of the park (**literary work**).
7. The *Golden China TV Game Centre* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in video games (**cinematograph films**).
8. The *Payen Components* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in a catalogue cum price list (**literary works**) relating to gaskets.
9. The *Waylite Diary* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in the appointment pages of a diary (**artistic/literary work**).
10. The *Juta* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in a book entitled "Silke on South African Income Tax" (**literary work**).
11. The *Frank & Hirsch* case deals with the alleged infringement of copyright in the wrappers and inserts, in other words the trade dress or get-up, of blank TDK audio cassette tapes (**artistic works**).
12. The *Bress* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in a M-shaped sofa (**artistic work**).
13. The *Fax Directories* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in a compilation of names, addresses and fax numbers called "The Pink Pages Fax Directory" (**literary work**). (p176B)

14. The *CCP Record Co* case was about the alleged copying of two long playing records (**sound recordings**) onto blank audio cassetts.
15. The *Galago* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in a historic novel on the role of the Selous Scouts in the Rhodesian Bush war (**literary work**), by a coffee table book on the same topic.
16. The *Klep Valves* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in engineering drawings (**artistic works**) relating to "diaphragm valves".
17. The *Bosal* case was about the alleged infringement of copyright in engineering drawings (**artistic works**) of exhaust systems, and its part numbering system as published in its catalogue (**literary work**).
