In your answer, evaluate the judgment in light of the theories of property distribution (20 Marks Wits Law School June 2012)
- 6. Fred Flintstone and his wife Kim Kardashianstone own a piece of property in Sandton. The City of Johannesburg then tells them that their property will be taken over by the City and they will not pay them a cent because they are the owners of all land in Johannesburg. Kim's lawyer, Mr West says that they are entitled to a pay out. With what you have learnt thus far, discuss the position of the law in this regard.
